

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Anaheim Housing Authority manages the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV, also known as “Section 8”) program for the City of Anaheim. The Housing Choice Voucher program provides rental assistance to eligible low-income families, which helps them afford safe, quality housing. The Anaheim Housing Authority will be accepting pre-applications online for the Housing Choice Voucher program waiting list beginning: Monday, July 29, 2019 at 10:00 am and closing on Friday, August 9, 2019 at 6:59 pm.

Pre-applications will be accepted online only at Anaheim.myhousing.com. Applications will not be accepted at the Housing Authority offices.

The waiting list will only be open for those who qualify for the Live or Work in Anaheim preference. You must indicate you either live in Anaheim or work in Anaheim to continue with the application. It is very important that ALL applicants read the preference criteria carefully and make sure to check each box for any eligible preferences. U.S. veterans will be given priority in the ordering of applications only, not in acceptance to the waiting list.

The Anaheim Housing Authority will accept only 10,000 applications. If more than 10,000 applications are received, a lottery will be performed to randomly determine which applications will be accepted to the waiting list. Additionally, the lottery will determine in which order applications are placed on the waiting list. This means that applicants have an equal chance of placement and order on the waiting list if they apply on any date and any time during which the waiting list is open.

The lottery will take place on August 13, 2019. After that time, applicants may check the status of their pre-application by logging into the application check system online at Anaheim.myhousing.com/status. Applicants will also be sent an email indicating if their application was accepted to the waiting list. This email will be sent to the email address provided by the applicant at the time of application.

As vouchers become available, pre-applications will be pulled from the waiting list in the order in which they were placed by the lottery.

To submit your application, you must provide Social Security numbers and birthdates for all members of your family, home and work address information, and household income.

APPLY ONLINE

Pre-applications must be submitted at Anaheim.myhousing.com. The applicant will receive a confirmation number when applying online.

Applicants can apply anywhere internet access is available. Applicants can also apply with any mobile device.

Applicants must have a valid email account prior to completing a pre-application.

Applicants who do not have access to a computer or mobile device can apply at the Anaheim Library locations listed below. To use a computer at a library you must have a library card or you may apply for one with a valid photo I.D.
